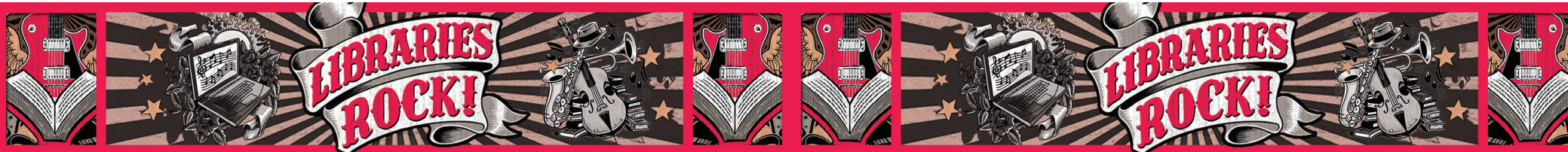

Rock & Roll Magic Bookshelf (Children)

What are the prizes for Adult Summer Reading?


