INTRODUCTION TO GENEALOGY CLASS

For the month of March, items from the Kretschmer Grocery Store and Wheat Germ Corporation will be on display. The Kretschmer Grocery store was located on South Jefferson Avenue in the mid-1900s, and the Wheat Germ Corporation operated in Carrollton from 1936-1964. The collection includes photographs, postcards, wheat germ jar prototypes, cookbooks and other memorabilia.

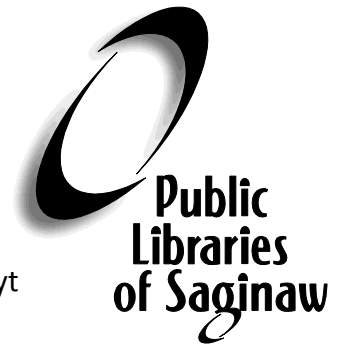
